#### **Conference Clinicians**

#### Dr. Shannon Jeffreys - Adult Clinician

Dr. Shannon Jeffreys is Professor of Music, Director of Choral Activities, and Assistant Dean for Student Experience in the College of Arts and Humanities at Georgia Southern University in Statesboro, Georgia. Her focus is the *Southern Chorale*, teaching in the undergraduate and graduate conducting and music education curriculums, along with directing *Southern Gentry* barbershop ensemble. Dr. Jeffreys has led these choirs in six international choral competitions and two national competitions where the choirs won significant awards. Most recently, Southern Chorale won both of their categories in the 2022 *Sing Berlin International Choral Competition*. In 2019, she received the Conductor's Award from the *Ave Verum International Choral Competition* in Baden, Austria. Choirs under her direction have also been featured at multiple state and national conferences recently performing at the National Collegiate Choral Organization's Conference.

Dr. Jeffreys maintains an active schedule as a presenter, adjudicator, lecturer and guest conductor from secondary to collegiate institutions and churches throughout the United States. She serves as an international choral adjudicator with *Meeting Music* and recently published in ACDA's *ChorTeach*.

Before coming to Georgia Southern, Jeffreys served as Director of Vocal Studies at Erskine College and Theological Seminary. She holds degrees in music performance and conducting from Birmingham Southern College, the University of Mississippi, and the University of South Carolina.

#### **Todd Arant – Youth Choir Clinician**

Todd Arant serves as the Director of Traditional Worship Arts at Apex United Methodist Church in Apex, NC. In his 14<sup>th</sup> year, Todd plans weekly worship services in the sanctuary and oversees a vibrant worship arts ministry that includes multiple vocal and instrumental choirs for adults, youth, and children. Todd earned the Bachelor of Music Degree (Church Music) from Furman University, the Master of Music Degree (Choral Conducting) from Emory University, and the Doctor of Worship Studies Degree from the Institute for Worship Studies. Outside of his church responsibilities, Todd directs The Glenaires, a 50-voice senior adult choir at Glenaire Retirement Community in Cary, NC. He is the Past President of the North Carolina Chapter for the Fellowship of United Methodists in Music and Worship Arts. Since 2015, he has served on the National Board of Directors for Choristers Guild, and in 2024, he begins a two-year term as President of the Board. Todd is married to Allison and a proud father of three children: Clarkson, Anna Rast, and Sims. He last served as the Youth Choir Clinician at Bonclarken Music Conference in 2022 and is honored to return to lead these youth again!

#### **Bethany Jennings – Middle School Clinician**

Ms. Bethany Jennings resides in McAdenville, NC - a small town near Charlotte otherwise known as Christmastown USA. She holds a Master of Music degree from the University of Mississippi (Ole Miss) and a Bachelor of Music Education from the University of North Carolina at Greensboro where she attended as a NC Teaching Fellow. Ms. Jennings is the Choral Director at Stuart W Cramer High School in Gaston County. In addition to her work at Stuart Cramer, she serves as Director of Music Ministries for the First Presbyterian Church in Gastonia, NC where she leads the Sanctuary Choir and Sanctuary Ringers. She is the founder of North Carolina's Collegiate Choral Symposium held annually in October and the Carolinas Conductor Summer Workshop held in August. Ms. Jennings was recently selected within the American Choral Directors Association as an International Conducting Fellow to South Africa, as well as invited to conduct the North Carolina Baptist All State Youth Tour Choir in the summer of 2023. Her professional affiliations include ACDA, PAM, Choristers Guild, and has served on the executive board of the High School Choral Section within the NC Music Educators Association for the past nine years. Away from the podium she LOVES being Aunt Beth, coaching basketball, and will eat anything but lima beans.

#### **David Mandt – Junior Choir Clinician**

David Mandt is entering his 5th year as the director of choirs at Mountain Brook High School in Birmingham, Alabama; he also works as the Senior Music Assistant for the Birmingham Boys Choir, where he works under Ken Berg. He completed his Bachelor's of Music Education from Florida State University, where he had the opportunity to work with the esteemed faculty there: Dr. Andre Thomas, Dr. Judy Bowers, and Dr. Kevin Fenton. He served as President of multiple musical organizations at Florida State; each of these ensembles competed and traveled internationally to Europe, Asia, and Central America. He also serves as a member of the state board for the Alabama chapter of the American Choral Directors' Association. He also sings with Iron City Singers, a semi-professional choir based out of Birmingham. He is currently an active clinician, judge, and conductor across the southeast. He regularly leads interest sessions and reading sessions at both regional and National ACDA Conferences. This will be his third time conducting at Bonclarken, and he is thrilled to return as a part of the Bonclarken family. He currently lives in Birmingham with his lovely wife, Aria.

#### Milette Oden – Cherub and Primary Choir Clinician

Milette Oden is the Director of Children's Music Ministry at First ARP Church in Gastonia, NC. She directs the Cherub and Junior Choirs for worship and special services, and coordinates the experiential music program Joyful Noise. Ms. Oden is also the Director of Choral Music and Lower School Music teacher at Gaston Day School, where she has taught since 2008. A native of Panama City, Florida, she holds a degree in Music Education from Birmingham-Southern College. Ms. Oden has 3 adult daughters and 2 cats.

#### **Andy Jacob – Conference Organist**

Andrew Jacob holds an active career as an organist and church musician. He currently serves as the Organist and Co-Director of Music at Augustana Lutheran Church in West St. Paul, MN, a congregation with a long history of excellence in the arts. His greatest joy at the organ comes when leading a worshiping congregation in song. He has led hymn festivals around the country in academic institutions and churches of various denominations and has been invited to coach hymn playing and improvisation techniques at continuing education conferences for organists and church musicians. In addition to his role at Augustana, Andy is the Music Director for St. Olaf College's (Northfield, MN) internationally syndicated sacred music radio program, *Sing for Joy*. Each week, the program airs sacred choral music following the scriptural lessons specified in the Revised Common Lectionary. A multiple prize recipient, he is the winner of the 2019 Ruth and Paul Manz Scholarship Competition administered by the Lutheran School of Theology at Chicago, the 2020 American Guild of Organists' Student Commissioning Project Grant, and the 2021 Richard VanScriver Church Music Scholarship in Organ through Metropolitan Music Ministries in Charlotte, NC. Andy earned a Bachelor of Arts degree in music from St. Olaf College and a Master of Music degree in organ performance from the University of North Carolina School of the Arts (UNCSA) where he was a Kenan Organ Scholar. His primary teachers have included Dr. Catherine Rodland and James Bobb at St. Olaf and Dr. Timothy Olsen at UNCSA.

## **General Information**

<u>Medical Issues</u>: Should an accident or injury occur that requires a hospital visit, a chaperone or church member from your group is responsible for taking the person to the hospital or urgent care. It is the church's responsibility to obtain medical forms, release forms and any other items pertaining to medical issues or medication during the time of the conference. Be sure to let the Bonclarken Office know.

<u>Chaperones:</u> One non-singing adult chaperone must accompany every ten participants and must accompany young children swimming. All participants (even one or two) are required to have an adult chaperone on the Bonclarken grounds. Chaperones are responsible for checking on all participants at all rehearsals and activities and enforcing Quiet Time.

<u>Children's Church</u>: This activity is for Junior, Primary, and Cherub choir members in the Rec Building. Children's Church will take place each morning during Morning Worship. Cherubs and Primaries will be escorted to crafts, recreation, or rehearsal by Music Conference counselors to the Rec Building, where they will be served a snack before Children's Church. Cherubs should be picked up PROMPTLY AT 10:40 AM in the old gym. Primary Choir members will be escorted to their next rehearsal by the counselors. Junior Choir members will join Children's Church at 10:20 AM after their rehearsal and will be escorted to their next activity by the counselors.

<u>Nibble Nook Devotions</u>: Nibble Nook Devotions are held nightly at 9:45 PM for Middle School and Youth Choir members, chaperones, and adults.

<u>Ice Cream, Snacks and soft drinks</u>: These are available for purchase at the Nibble Nook. Hours are: Monday - Thursday from 1:00 - 5:00 PM, 7:45 - 11:00 PM. Friday hours are 1:00 - 5:00, 9:00 - midnight.
